Investment Bank Moelis Files IPO

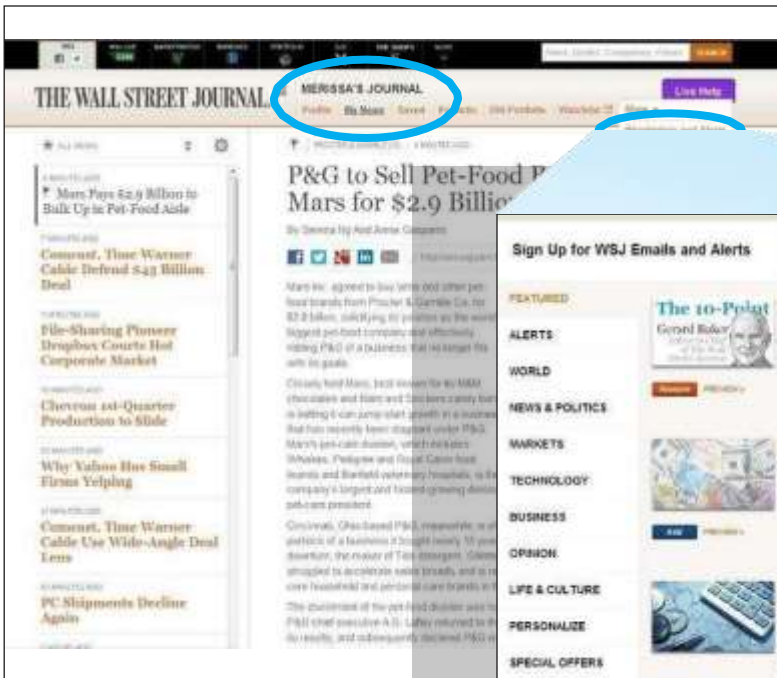

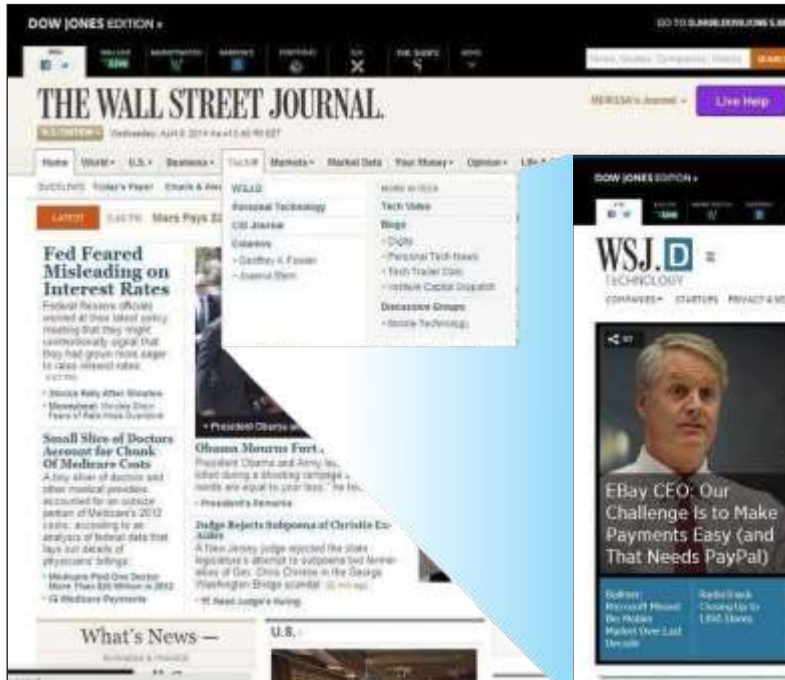
